

President Xi Jinping Writes a Reply Letter to Bill Gates

2020/02/22

On 20 February, President Xi Jinping wrote a letter in reply to Bill Gates, co-chair of the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation, thanking him and the Foundation for their support for China's fight against the novel coronavirus disease (COVID-19) and calling for enhanced international coordination and concerted efforts against the outbreak.

"Now is a critical moment in China's fight against the novel coronavirus disease (COVID-19)," Xi wrote. "I deeply appreciate the act of generosity of the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation and your letter of solidarity to the Chinese people at such an important moment."

The Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation, co-founded by Gates and his wife, has worked with China in disease prevention and control, poverty alleviation and other fields for many years. On 27 January, the Foundation committed 5 million US dollars in emergency funding to support China's fight against COVID-19, and later pledged up to 100 million US dollars, part of which will help China accelerate the development of vaccines, treatments and diagnostics. In his recent letter to President Xi, Bill Gates commended the Chinese government and people for the strong epidemic response and expressed firm support to China in prevailing over the outbreak.

Bill Gates says privately he donated \$50m to Kamala Harris campaign - report

Gates, who has not publicly endorsed Harris, reportedly expressed concern about a second Trump presidency

Bill Gates has reportedly said privately that he recently donated \$50m to a non-profit organization supporting **Kamala Harris**'s US presidential run, remarking: "This election is different".

Three people briefed on the matter told the New York Times: "The donation was meant to stay under wraps."
